On Good Friday, Santuario de Chimayo hosts a procession representing the **suffering and death of Jesus Christ**. At 12:00 noon, five "pasos", or stages of the passion of Our Lord, are carried by volunteers from the Santo Niño Chapel to the Christ of Esquipulas Chapel. Volunteers are welcome to take part in the procession carrying a "paso", a candlestick, or a processional cross.

REQUIREMENTS TO ENGAGE IN THE PROCESSION:

Volunteers, pilgrims and visitors are called to reflect upon the final hours of Jesus in Jerusalem. Those taking part and following the procession show a prayerful behavior and focus respectfully on the representation.

Volunteers take part in a **representation of the sufferings of Jesus**. Those who are not in good physical and emotional condition, or cannot withstand hot or cold weather, sweat and heavy weight, should refrain from volunteering.

Volunteers contact Santuario de Chimayo by going to the Welcome Center, by phone or e-mail. El Santuario will contact the volunteers notifying them they have been accepted to carry a "paso," or the processional cross or a candlestick, during the Good Friday procession.
